**Norwich, CT Police to Distribute Accident Reports with PoliceReports.US**

The Norwich, CT Police Department has begun to distribute PR-1 Accident Reports online with PoliceReports.US this month. “More than half the incoming correspondence generated from the Records Division is requests for accident reports”, stated Lt.
